

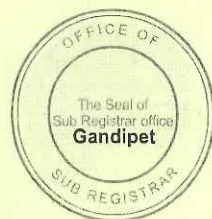

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The trust shall be an irrevocable charitable public educational, cultural trust for the benefit of all persons belonging to whatever community irrespective of Caste, Creed or Religion, the Trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus endowed by the Author of the trust and such other properties (both movable and immovable) as may be acquired from time to time by the Trust, by purchase, exchange, grant, allotment, subscription, endowment, donation, contribution, or in any manner to whatsoever (all of which shall be designed as Trust properties) on the Trust herein mentioned.

4. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES:

The number of Trustees including the Author of the Trustees shall not be less than THREE and not more than ELEVEN persons. The Board of Trustees shall nominate and invite person/persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.

5. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:

These Trustees shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the board of trustees.

6. MANAGING TRUSTEE:

(i) The day-to-day administration of the Trust shall be looked after by the Managing Trustee under the guidance, control and supervision of the Board of Trustees.

(ii) The Board of Trustees shall nominate one amongst the trustees as specified in para (4) above to be the Managing Trustee, who shall hold office for such period, as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.

7. VACANCIES:

Any vacancy among the Members of the Board of Trustees may be filled by the trustees as specified in para (4) above or their successors and they shall hold office for such durations may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

8. TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:

- vii) Upon expiry of the period up to which the Board of trustees have nominated the trustee.

9. MEETINGS AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall ordinarily meet at least once in a calendar year or as often as may be necessary for the satisfactory conduct of the affairs of the Trust. In every meeting all the Trustees present shall elect a President for the meeting.

Minutes of the meeting shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting and be kept in the safe custody.

10. NOTICE:

SEVEN days Notices shall ordinarily be given for a meeting of Board of Trustees or such notice time as may be necessary or possible for the conduct of affairs of the Trust.

11. QUORUM:

The Quorum for the Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be TWO numbers.

12. VOTING:

Decisions of the Board of Trustees may be made at a meeting or by circulation of papers to them. Normal matters of routine nature may be circulated and decision obtained. The important matters are to be decided at the meeting. All matters arising for disposal shall be decided by a majority of the Board of Trustees present at the Meeting. The President of the Board of Trustees shall have a casting vote in the event of equality of votes, in addition to his own.

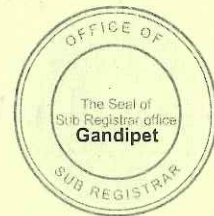

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13. POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

- (a) All property of the Trust Movable or Immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in trust, the trustee shall manage the whole property and affairs of the trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary, proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the trust.
- (b) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the trustees shall for the purposes of this Trust have the following powers, duties and functions:
- (i) To acquire by Gift, Grant, Purchase, Exchange, Lease, or otherwise, lands, buildings, or other immovable properties and also any Movable Property.
- (ii) To construct and maintain buildings, to alter, to demolish or improve them and equip them suitably.
- (iii) To accept gifts, donations, endowment and contributions for the Trust in cash or kind from any person(s), body of persons, Trusts, Companies, Firms, Government, with or without conditions.
- iv) To raise necessary funds for maintaining the activities of the trust and its organs for fulfilling the aims and objectives.
- v) To accept any trust, trust fund or endowment so long as the provisions of such Trust or endowment are in consonance with the objects of this Trust.
- vi) To award scholarship and make donations calculated to promote the objects of the Trust.
- vii) To enter into contracts, or engagements or assignments on behalf of the Trust.

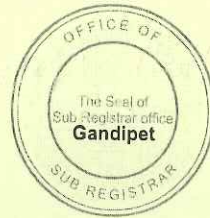

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- viii) To consider such proposals submitted by Sub-committee appointed by this Trust and allocate such funds as deemed necessary for the implementation of the programs.
- ix) To make, sign and execute all such documents instruments, as may be necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the properties and affairs of the Trust.
- x) To invest such monies and such funds of the trust and to vary the investment as and when it may seem necessary or proper provided that such investments shall be made only upon immovable properties or upon securities as the Board of Trustees may deem fit, under section 11 (5) of Income Tax Act, 1956.
- xi) To acquire movable or immovable properties for the fulfillment of objectives and for smooth functioning of the trust from time to time
- xii) To appoint Committee/Committees of management for such terms and with such powers as may be specified from time to time, for carrying on the routine management of the affairs of the Trust.
- xiii) To appoint such employees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the trust and exercise control all such employees including the power of suspension, dismissal and removal.
- xiv) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.

- xxi) To delegate to the Managing Trustee or any appointed committee such powers, duties and functions as are vested in the Trustees.

- xxiii) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- xxiv) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake property, assets and other movable and immovable properties in the name of trust as decided by trustees as per their discretion.
- xxv) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to spend the income of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.

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


- xxvi) If the Trustees are desirous of altering, changing, modifying, deleting or adding any clause or clauses of their Trust deed they shall do so as per the provisions of the Indian Trust Act, with the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax having jurisdiction over the Trust and by following necessary procedures and prescribed by the Indian Trust Act.

The Trustee shall do so with the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax having jurisdiction over the Trust and on such terms and on such terms and conditions the commissioner of Income Tax shall impose and the transfer of the assets shall be done as mentioned above, only to the trusts, Societies, institutions or organizations having similar objects as that of this trust and which are having registration under Section 12 A & under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act and the properties handed over as stated above to other trust, societies, institutions or organizations shall bear the name of Trust and shall be maintained as separate entity by the absorbing Trust.


14. BANK ACCOUNT:

17. DEFECTS OF PROCEDURE IMMATERIAL: ✓

No act of Trustees shall be invalidated by reason only of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or any irregularity in the proceedings of the Board of Trustees or any Committee thereof.

18. AMENDMENTS:

No amendments to the Trust Deed shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

20. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST:




21. RESIDUARY:
